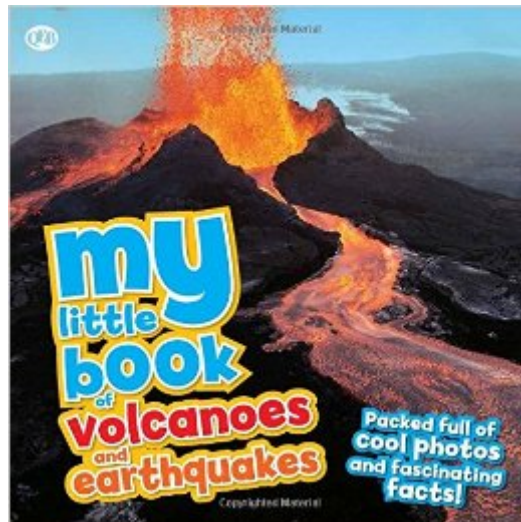

Teaches the basics of earth science from volcanoes to earthquakes and more. It didn't overly thrill me or overly excite me - but it was very educational. I really did not like though that some photos were placed over the crack between pages - especially when what the text was referring to like the shape of the volcanoes peak but you could not see it because it was lost in the crease. If they fixed that problem, the book would have been 4 stars.

I wasn't quite ready to explain to my kid that volcanos and earthquakes can hurt people and destroy homes. He's really into volcanos right now and I'm struggling to find a book that doesn't have photos

of things getting destroyed. This isn't it.

This well-bound book series contains full-page photos, brief descriptions, and fun fact bullet points, scattered around each two-page spread, to explain to children about the power (and tragedy) of these hard to understand aspects of life on Earth. I went through some earthquakes when I was a child, and learned about tragic events unfolding elsewhere, and found them confusing. This book helps to explain to children why, how, and the history of such things, which should help eliminate some confusion, and hopefully, some fear on the subject.

My four year old LOVES this book. We have read it over and over. The information is presented at a much more basic level than some of the other kids science books, and he needed very little help understanding the basic concepts.

Great book for older elementary age kids. Really colorful illustrations and very easy to read. Simple explanations that allow kids to enjoy learning about the volcanoes and earthquakes. A really great book ~ definitely should be in all elementary libraries!
